TOPIC: "Eocene Poway Conglomerate: Provenance, Depositional  
Environments and Post-Depositional Displacements."  
This presentation will be a synthesis of the current  
state of knowledge concerning the Poway Conglomerate.  
The talk will be based on published and unpublished  
data concerning sediment transportation experiments  
and trace element determinations by Drs. Abbott and  
Gary Peterson, stratigraphic studies by Michael  
Kennedy and George Moore, depositional environment  
studies by David Howell and Marty Link, and work  
by John Minch on modes of clast transport. All of  
us working in or studying the Poway (Stadium) Con-  
glomerate should find this talk very interesting and  
informative.
