- SPEAKER: Dr. Bert Swan, Dr. Swan received his Ph.D. from John Hopkins University with a specialty in Quaternary Stratigraphy in Soil Strata. He has been with Woodward-Clyde Consultants for 5 years doing fault activity studies relating to dams and nuclear power plant sites in Washington State, Illinois, California, Egypt and Israel.
- TOPIC: "Use of Paleosols for Assessing Fault Activity in the Western Sierran Foothills". Talk will be a discussion of the techniques used to assess the ages and amount of fault displacement of buried paleosols in the western Sierran foothills. These studies were done for the P.G. & E. for power plant siting and earthquake evaluation at Auburn and New Melones dams.
