Topic: Late Quaternary Geology of the Camp Pendleton -

San Onofre Coastal Area

Roy Shlemon, Soil Stratigrapher par excellence, will present the details of some of his work done in the San Onofre-Camp Pendleton area. Much of this work was performed in conjunction with and reviewed by such entities as the NRC and Southern California Edison. Roy will speak on the neotectonics of the area, soil stratigraphic and radiometric age dating, rates of soil development and its relationship to lost movement on the Christianitos Fault System.

Dr. Shlemon is a well known soil stratigrapher who has performed his magic, on a consulting basis, for many of the major geotechnical and geologic firms and review agencies in the west. His experience is, in fact, world-wide, with having visited many of the best and worst places in the world in the name of SCIENCE. To top it all off, Roy is a nice guy and a heck of a speaker.
