Date: February 22, 1984

Topic: The Relationship of Plio-Pleistocene Alluvial Deposits and Thrust Faulting in the Santa Cruz Mountains

Lee Vanderhurst will discuss his work on the Santa Clara Formation and its relationship with mountain building along the eastern front of the Santa Cruz Mountains. Using Lithofacies mapping within the Santa Clara Formation, Lee has postulated a 3.5 million year history of thrust faulting along the Sargent-Berrocal Fault in the San Francisco Bay Area.

Speaker: Mr. Lee Vanderhurst, Senior Geologist, San Diego Soils Engineering, Inc.

Lee received his B.S. at SDSU and his M.S. at San Jose State. After receiving his Masters Degree at San Jose, Lee worked for three years in northern California. Subsequent to that time, he brought his wife and surfboard to San Diego, where he has worked as a consultant since 1979⁺.
