Speaker: Dr. Perry Ehlig, Professor of Geology at California State University, Los Angeles and Engineering Geology Consultant

Topic: Portuguese Bend Landslide and Landslide Abatement - Mechanics and Proposed Stabilization Measures. The Portuguese Bend Landslide is the oldest, biggest and most rapidly moving of four large active landslides within a Late Pleistocene landslide complex on the south slope of Palos Verdes Peninsula. The Portuguese Bend Landslide consists of approximately 260 acres and has had continuous movement ranging from 0.1 to 1.0 inch per day since 1956. Preliminary stabilization measures consist of a combination of dewatering, drainage improvements, and redistribution of mass within the slide.
