
The Swiss, Austrian, and Italian Alps have had a long history of large destructive landslides. Many villages are perched on steep-sided valleys and are in continual threat of rock avalanche or massive landsliding. Several arctiont slides such as the long run-out landslide at Flims, Switzerland, the Goldau Slide, and the deadly Val Pola Slide in northern Italy will be discussed. Some examples of erosion and landslide protective works will also be presented.

Mike Hart is a graduate of SDSU (B.A. 1964, M.S. 1972) and a California Certified Engineering Geologist. Material for his M.S. thesis on landsliding was obtained while working as a staff geologist for Wm. Krooskos and Assoc. from 1968-75. In 1975 he joined Geocon as Principal Geologist and in November 1992 became an independent consultant. Mike is past chairman of SDAG and is a past officer of the Southern Cal section of AEG. He is currently management board representative for the Engineering Geology Division of GSA.
