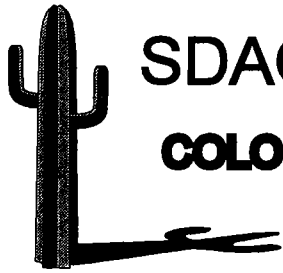

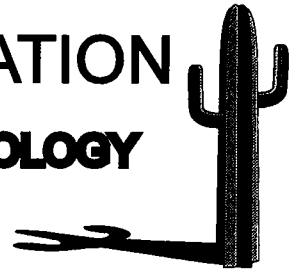

## SDAG 1993 FIELD TRIP INFORMATION COLORADO DESERT AND SALTON TROUGH GEOLOGY



This year's low-budget, but still interesting SDAG field trip, will be by private vehicle, carpool, convoy and caravan and will begin Saturday at 7:00 AM, Nov. 6, 1993 in the north parking area of the Desert Kitchen Cafe in scenic Ocotillo, CA. Coffee, juice and rolls will be provided during the orientation and check-in period.

Since travel will be by private vehicles, it is requested that carpooling be utilized to minimize the number of vehicles on the field trip. Contact Joe Coronas for carpool assignments ( see registration form, on reverse side ).

### **Saturday:**

We will be visiting the Superstition Hills, Geothermal Production Plant, Mud Volcanoes, Durmid Hills and Mecca Hills where we will camp for the night.

### **Sunday:**

We will visit Painted Canyon, Indio Hills, a scenic overlook/ rest-stop above Palm Desert and return to San Diego via Anza Borrego.

The camp site will be primitive with no water or restrooms available, so plan accordingly. If you have access to a C.B. Radio that receives channel 11 bring it along, it will help the trip run smoother. Any Ham Radio Operators will be able to use 2-meter equipment. Frequencies will be available with the next newsletter/ field trip flyer.
