SDAG FIELD TRIP

Geology of the Alberhill Clays and Paloma Ring Complex

The annual SDAG field trip will be held October 22nd -24th, 2021. The trip will visit the Alberhill Clay Bed and Paloma Ring Complex in Southwestern Riverside County. Carpooling is recommended. The trip includes the option to camp Friday night. The trip starts Saturday morning at the Lake Skinner Group Campground area B, Winchester, CA. We will carpool from this location to the first stop, an overview at Greer Ranch to view the Paloma Ring Complex. Afterwards we head to the Menifee History Museum and have lunch. Next we will stop at El Sobrante Landfill to view the pisolitic clay beds of Alberhill. Saturday ends back at the group camp site with the option to stop at local wineries on the way to camp. At camp you will be able to hike the local trails, and enjoy a catered dinner with local beer and wine. After breakfast Sunday morning we head south to visit the Europa Village Winery to view their newly constructed wine cave, then to the Oak Mountain Winery to view their wine cave. The trip ends at the Oak Mountain Winery, where there are several lunch options. Wine tastings are not included in the cost of the trip. Please bring your copy of the “Geology & Enology of the Temecula Valley” publication, if you have one.

The campsite is limited to 32 vehicles, though overflow parking is available. The trip includes a continental breakfast on Saturday, lunch, Saturday night dinner will be catered in camp, and liquids. Sunday- breakfast in camp is also included. Field Trip details will be emailed to participants, so please list your preferred email address.

In consideration of being allowed to participate on behalf of San Diego Geological Society, Inc. and San Diego Association of Geologists and related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist; and,
