

San Diego Association of Geologists (SDAG) - Field Trip Oct 6-8, 2023

EASTERN SAN DIEGO COUNTY PENINSULAR RANGES

This year's trip takes us into the eastern San Diego County Peninsular Ranges. The trip takes place October 6 to 8, 2023 (Fri, Sat, Sun). We camp both nights at the Boulevard KOA Campground located about 7 miles south of Interstate 8. Full days Saturday and Sunday are planned. The trip focuses on geological stops north and south of I-8 which are included in SDAG's 2022 2nd edition of Dr. Mike Walawender's book *The Peninsular Ranges: A Geologic Guide to San Diego's Back Country*. Additional geologic stops are planned to include the Mica Gem Mine, the Carrizo Overlook, the Mountain Springs Landslide, Desert View Tower, and the historic location of the Buckman Springs Water bottling facility.

Our KOA group camp area includes tent camping and room for 8 in a bunkhouse. For those not interested in tent/bunkhouse camping, the KOA offers Full RV hook up sites and cabins. In addition, the newly renovated Jacumba Hot Springs Hotel will be open the first of October. RV sites, Cabins and/or Hotels are not included in the registration cost and must be reserved independently.

The registration form on page 2 can be paid by credit, cash or check at an SDAG meeting; or you can print page 2 and see instructions to mail your form with a check. Paid reservations must be received no later than Sept 22nd, 2023. The trip is limited to the first 50 paid.

What is included in your fee:

- Field Trip Road Log & SDAG Trip Logo Item.
- 2 nights KOA Tent Camping (Section E): Bring your own camping equipment. OR
- 2 nights KOA Bunkhouse with 8 beds (Section E): Bring your own sleeping bag. First come first serve, please note in your form.
- KOA group camp area: includes tables, fire pits, water, electricity.
- KOA Property: includes restrooms, showers, pool, hot tub, playground, dog park, labyrinth, hiking trails, office with store, WIFI. Pets welcome on leash.
- 5 Meals: Saturday continental breakfast, lunch, BBQ dinner. Sunday hot Breakfast, lunch. If you have vegetarian/vegan needs please note in your form.
- Snacks and beverages.

What is <u>not</u> included in your fee:

- Friday Night Dinner: Options are to cook in camp or drive to a local restaurant.
- Transportation/4X4: Carpooling is highly recommended; we can help with coordination. Parking is limited at the campground and at field trip stops. High Clearance 4X4 vehicles are necessary for several Field Trips stops.
