TOPIC:

"Landslides Down Under- Southern Australia and New Zealand" An overview of the 12-day field trip which highlighted the 5th International Conference on Landslides held in Australia and New Zealand in August 1987. The field trip began in Sydney and proceeded southwesterly to Melbourne where numerous "soil slips" were observed. Several days were spent on the island of Tasmania examining landslides along the Tasmanian Sea. From there the group moved to New Zealand to observe several large landslides, some of which have moved since being covered with subdivisions. The trip also stopped at the Clyde Dam where large landslides and active faults were mapped.
