A (VERY) SHORT COURSE ON THE IDENTIFICATION OF PALEOLANDSLIDES

A very short course on the identification of Paleolandslides will be presented for an hour by Mike Hart as the Wednesday January 18, 2023 SDAG monthly meeting. The course is intended for engineering geologists wanting to improve their landslide identification skills. The course will take you through a landslide time warp beginning with how a slide looks at infancy through old age and the last topographic evidence of existence. Although intended primarily for professional geologists with no or little experience with landslide investigations it should also be of interest to geotechnical engineers wanting to gain an understanding of how geologists identify landslides by their diagnostic landforms. A take-home mapping exercise to gauge their new landslide identification skills will be available on request

Biography

Mike is a Certified Engineering Geologist and has practiced in the southern California area for over 50 years. Mike is a graduate of San Diego State University (M.S.1972, Landslides of West-Central San Diego County, California). Since leaving Geocon 1992 he has been an independent engineering geology consultant. His interest in landsliding began during undergraduate studies at SDSU; an interest that ultimately led to a career-long, slightly irrational, fascination with landslides. Mike has been involved with numerous landslide investigations and has published extensively on landsliding in southern California.


