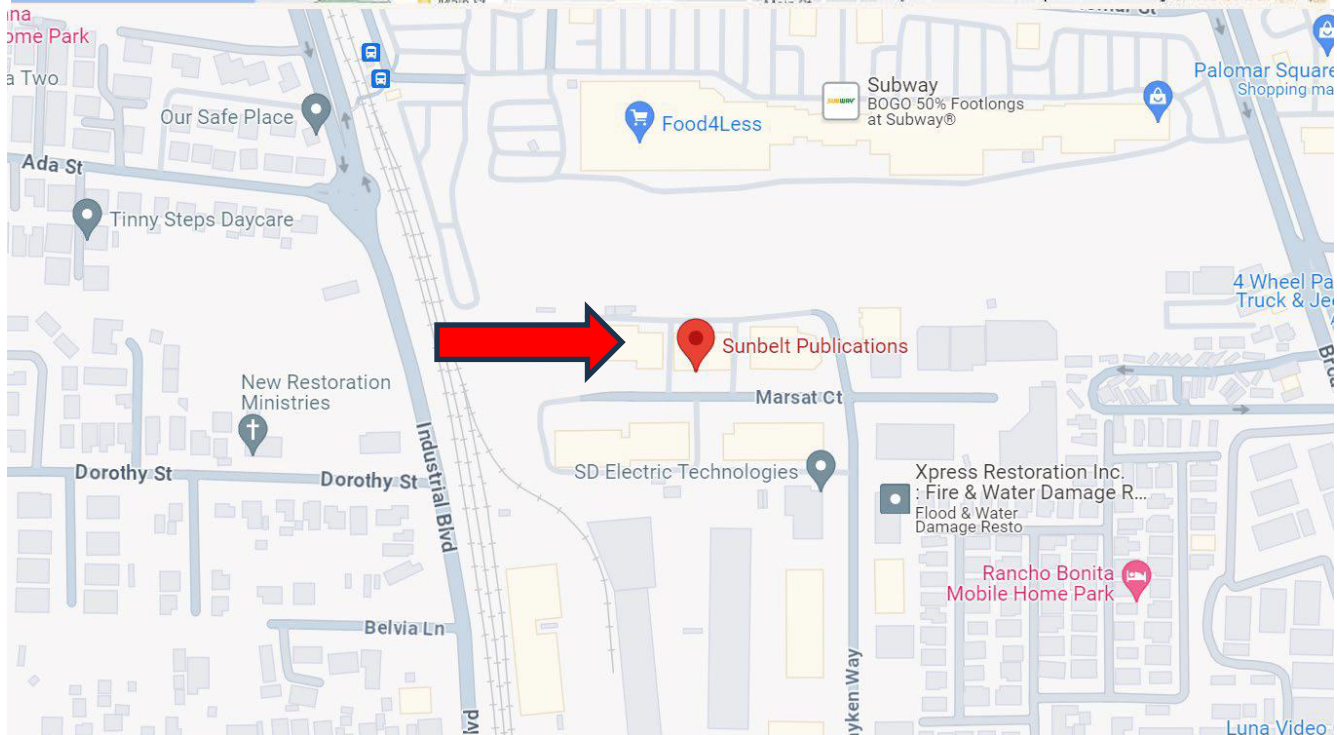
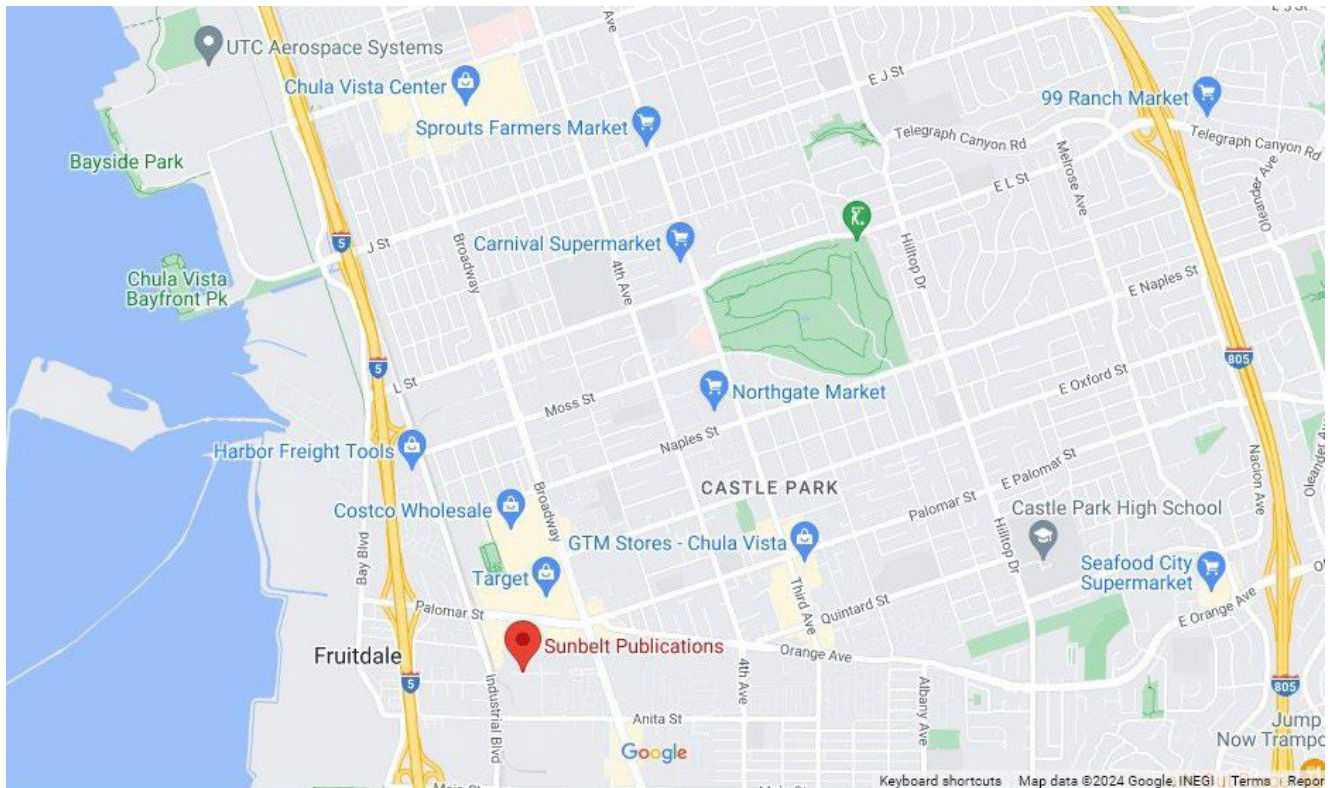

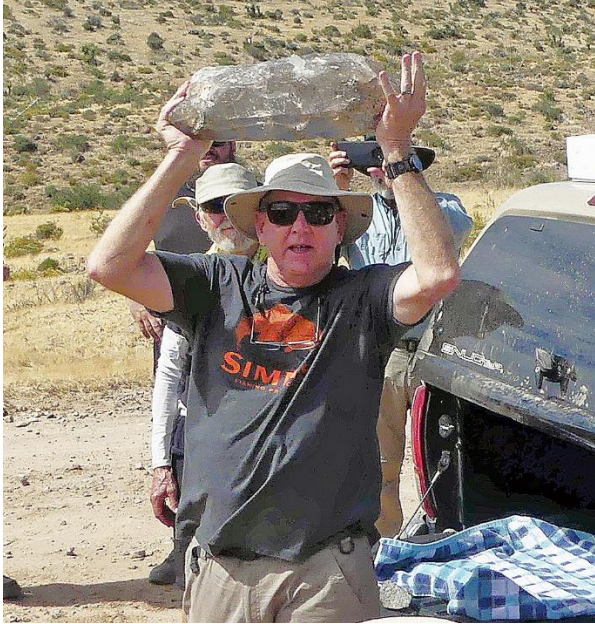
From I-5:

5. Park on the street, or in the parking lot in the back.

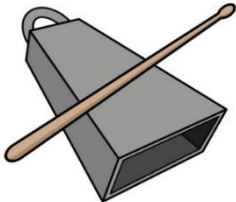
From I-805:

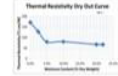
